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### Online Course Enrollment Options

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### Testing for Placement

We would like to remind you again that all participants must take the placement test. And it must be received by your actual start date. The grading process may take (1 to 10) business days. So please allow ample amounts of time for your submission inshaAllah. The results of the test will not be forwarded to you; this test is not a pass/fail mechanism.

May Allah grant you tawfeeq and increase you upon the path in seeking beneficial knowledge ameen!

Before you submit your placement test, please make sure that you have completed all parts of your application submission including the last portion of the placement test. THM does accept faxed submissions for the placement test. However, because of distortion of the text you maybe asked to resubmit by other means inshaAllah. You can also email or mail the test to us.

The placement test is not a pass/fail testing mechanism. It is solely used for measuring the comprehension and understanding of the participants who enroll for the program. This process helps the production of worksheets and assignments from Instructors to be given.

Younger children are not expected to answer certain questions on this test, but are permitted to do so if the answer is known to them. Prompting your children with examples to jar the memory is fine. However, we suggest that you allow them to recall the information on their own and to the best of their ability inshaAllah.

## **Placement Test Requirements**

1. Each participant enrolling for online access needs to complete and submit here: [testing@thmteach.org](mailto:testing@thmteach.org)
2. Categories we are checking for the placement test include written essay/composition, grammar, punctuation, spelling, vocabulary, research and a questionnaire.
3. Subjects for this placement test may include reading and comprehension, Tawheed, Aqeedah, Seerah, Qur'an, and General Islamic studies.
4. Additional subjects include questions on the Seerah, Companions and other biographies.
5. Participants may use any text that is available to them from personal books, authentic websites offering information, etc.
6. Please remember to properly quote your sources when used. Example: 1<sup>st</sup> Hadith “narrated by Abu Hurairah, name of article found on Troid.org, reported in Sahih Bukhari & Muslim or using the expression “Agreed Upon”.
7. The placement test is due one week to ten days before your start date! No exceptions. Your start date will be processed according to the date of submission only.
8. Once you have submitted your placement test. If you have not already done so, you need to subscribe to your class online. It is free. ## Section II: Grammar/Punctuation/Structure

Some sections of the test become increasingly more difficult. Students who are 2<sup>nd</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> Grade are not expected to answer certain questions. As the age level increases the questions become harder. All other participants are expected to answer all questions to the best of their ability inshaAllah. If you must skip a question type D/K\* next to it!

1. It is important that students recognize a group of words that make a complete sentence. Look carefully at each group of words. Read the group of words. Write yes or no if the group of words forms a complete sentence. Punctuation at the end of a group of words does not necessarily mean that the words form a sentence inshaAllah.

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6. In each sentence there is always a predicate, the predicate also known as the verb, names an action or state of being. The predicate tells what the subject does or is. From the sentences in number 5, write down your predicates below.

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7. The complete sentence contains the subject and all the words that describe it are called the “complete subject”: example: Five Egyptian handmade Abayas; the verb and all the words that describe it are called “the complete predicate”: example: can be purchased for only \$100.00.

“Five Egyptian abayas can be purchased for only \$100.00.”

Write three sentences that contain a complete subject and complete predicate. Then underline the complete subject.

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## Section IV: Questionnaire

The questionnaire is designed to ask a series of focused questions regarding Islam. Please pay close attention to what is being asked from you. Subjects vary and become increasingly more difficult. Again, for younger participants we do not expect for them to answer questions beyond their capability but encourage them to answer if they know what is being asked of them inshaAllah. All other participants please answer the questions to the best of your ability. Vocabulary and spelling are included for this section.

- What is the meaning of *Ar-Rabb*?
- Who is *Allah*?
- Where is *Allah*?
- Allah created man and jinn for what purpose?
- What are the *five pillars* of Islam?
- What do you say when you take *Shahadah*?
- At what age should a child begin to pray?
- What is the meaning of *Tawheed*?
- Name the three categories of Tawheed.
- Why are we encouraged to give proof for our statements?
- What is a Qur'aan?
- Is the Qur'aan the word/speech of Allah?
- Allah says: "Say, He Allah is One", where can I find that ayaat?
- When was the Qur'aan revealed?
- As a muslim we must have knowledge of three things, what are they?
- Allah is our Lord, but how did we arrived at this knowledge of our Rabb?
- Name three types of worship with their meanings.
- What is the meaning of *taghut*?
- Does *Al-Ibaadah* refer of Tawheed? Explain.

- What is Allah's right upon mankind?
- What is the servant's right upon Allah?
- Who is the prophet's full name?
- What is the point of the following hadeeth?

Why do you ask Why or what or any other thing?

'Umar Ibn Al-Kattab also narrated that the Prophet Muhammad (صلى الله عليه و سلم) said: Musa (alaihi wa salaam) said: My Lord! May I see Adam who removed us and himself from the paradise?' So Allah made him see Adam, and He said to him: 'Are you Adam?
