INSTRUCTION SHEET (6) Weeks

Alhamdulillah, you have reached our first six weeks of school. We are currently completing work in the first semester of school. The purpose of this pretesting series is to evaluate how much of the content you have retained over the past few weeks and how much you were able to achieve in comprehension of subjects given inshaAllah

Each day for the next four days you will be given a minimum of three subjects per day to complete. There are not less than thirty (30) questions per subject. Each question requires explanation of terms. Your answers should be given in full sentence structure. You are reminded that the question should be used in part for your answer (restating the question). Short answers are not acceptable.

Example: Q1: Name the complete subject and complete predicate in each sentence.

A1: The Hijra calendar (cs) is determined by the sighting of the moon. (cp)

Once you have completed your exam for the day, you are instructed to complete current assignments due; you are **not done** for the day. Check each answer for correct punctuation, grammar usage, and sentence structure before submitting the paper through email. Your test submission is due the SAME class period! Your short story or essay will be graded at the end of the testing session. Don't forget as you will receive a 0% as a final grade if not submitted.

Any student missing portions of the exam due to absence or lateness will need to schedule a one hour block of (make-up) time afterschool between 3:00pm – 5:00pm only. For makeup test - All parts of the exam must be completed and submitted by Thursday at 5:00pm no exceptions.
