INSTRUCTION SHEET

Alhamdulillah, you have reached the half-way mark for our first six weeks of school. We are currently completing work in the first semester of school. The purpose of this pretesting series is to evaluate how much of the content you have retained over the past few weeks and how much you were able to achieve in comprehension of subjects given inshaAllah

Each day for the next two days you will be given a minimum of three to six subjects to complete. There are not less than five questions per subject. Each question requires explanation of terms. Your answers should be given in full sentence structure. You are reminded that the question should be used in part for your answer (restating the question). Short answers are not acceptable.

Example: Q1: How many days are there in a lunar month?

A1: The Hijra calendar is determined by the sighting of the moon.

There are twenty-nine or thirty days in a lunar calendar month.

Once you have completed your exam for the day, you are instructed to complete other assignments due. Check each answer for correct punctuation, grammar usage, and sentence structure before turning the paper in. Your test submission is due the SAME DAY! Your portfolio writing/paragraphs will be graded on Thursday. Your paragraphs should be handed in (Wednesday). Don't forget as you will receive a 0% as a final grade if not submitted.

Any student missing portions of the exam due to absence or lateness will need to schedule a two hour block of (make-up) time afterschool today between 3:00pm – 5:00pm only. All exams must be completed and submitted by Thursday at 5:00pm no exceptions.
