

Reading Letters with the Vowel: Kasrah

How to Read This Exercise: First say the name of the letter, then the name of the harakah (tashkeel), then the sound it makes.

Example: اَ say: "Hamzah kasrah 'e" هَ say: "Haa kasrah he"

- The letters in the **Turquoise boxes** are *mufakhkhamah* (pronounced heavy, with tafkheem.)
- The letters are arranged according to their *Makhaarij* (articulation points), starting from the deepest part of the throat (هـ) and moving up through the mouth to the lips (ف و ب م).
