1. Describe the procedure and method of raising the hands in salaah as has been mentioned from Anas bin Malik, Abu Hurairah, Nafi', and Abu Qilaba just to name a few, list the procedure and methods.
2. From the hadith we have learned that during the eclipse, the Prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa sallaam) offered salaah. In the salaah he was shown something, what was it? Give details from the other hadith as well.
3. Alhamdulillah, name some of the suwar that the prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa sallaam) used to recite for maghrib and Isha salaah?
4. Explain how the prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa sallaam) completed his recitation for Fajr, and Asr prayers?
5. When sitting in the salaah, can we place our hands between the knees?

Volume 1, Book 12, Number 724:

*Narrated Abu Hurairah:*

*...The Prophet said, "When you stand for Prayer say Takbir and then recite from the Holy Qur'an (of what you know by heart) and then bow till you feel at ease. Then raise your head and stand up straight, then prostrate till you feel at ease during your prostration, then sit with calmness till you feel at ease (do not hurry) and do the same in all your prayers"*

Volume 1, Book 12, Number 739:

*Narrated Abu Hurairah:*

*The Qur'an is recited in every prayer and in those prayers, in which Allah's Apostle recited aloud for us, we recite aloud in the same prayers for you; and the prayers in which the Prophet recited quietly, we recite quietly. If you recite "Al-Fatihah" only it is sufficient but if you recite something else in addition, it is better.*
