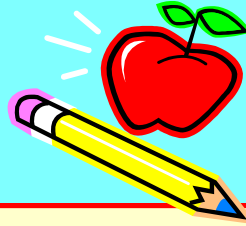

The Month of Ramadan

For this blessed month (excluding breaks) students are geared toward Quran/Tafsir reading in their Homeschool instruction. We began our reading with Vol. 10 of Ibn Kathir (Surah at-Taghabun – 64). During the 2nd (10 days) of Ramadan students are required to complete a daily summary in their journals about their current activities during Ramadan. The summary should include things like the current suwar they are studying or reading, preparing Iftar, visiting the Masjid, reading other books, benefits from a lecture, or Tafsir, etc...
