

The life of The Noble Prophet



Lesson 1: The Heart of the Muslim is filled with love for the Prophet (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam)

The heart of the Muslim/Muslimah is filled with the love of the last Prophet Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) and this love for the Messenger of Allah is an asset for him/her. Love and respect for a person depends on the benefits, we get from him. As for the Prophet he is the greatest of benefits for all of humanity. Every Muslim should have the deepest love for him.

Every deed of the Prophet Muhammad's (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) life is to be followed by every individual of the Muslim Ummah (community). Loving the Prophet has been made a test for your faith.

Allah says:

"Say (O Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) to mankind): If you really love Allah then follow me (Islamic Monotheism, The Quran and The Sunnah), Allah will love you..." 3:31

Love of the messenger of Allah is a part of our faith. There is a hadith that says:

"None of you has faith unless I am dearer to him than his father and his son and all of mankind."

Bits of Knowledge:

The biography of the life of our noble prophet Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) is a very good reference of study when wanting to learn who he is. You may take your time and read through the revised copy of "The Sealed Nectar" by Safi-ur-Rahman Al-Mubarakpuri. This text will aid you in these lessons, inshaAllah. You may also use The Noble Quran, along with various ahaadith from Sahih Bukhari, Muslim, Dawuud, and At-Tirmidhi. Other resources will be sited as we move along.

The Prophet Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) the seal of the prophets was born in Bani Hashim in Mecca on a Monday morning, in the month of Rabi'Al-Awwal the same year of the Elephant (surah 105) event told in the Quran. He became a prophet when he was 40 years of age.

Important things to remember inshaAllah:

Whenever you see, here, or read the name of the Prophet Muhammad you should be reminded to send salaams upon him by saying (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) this means "May the blessings and peace of Allah be upon him." Allah has stated in Surah Al-Ahzab: 56 "Allah sends His Salaat (Graces, Honors, Blessings, Mercy) on the Prophet (Muhammad -(Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam), and

also His angels (ask Allah to bless and forgive him). O you who believe! Send your Salat on him, and greet him with the Islamic way of greeting (As-salaamu Alaikum)."

Do not become lazy in this affair for it is a command from Allah Ya Muslimoon!

The Prophet Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) has warned us in the Sunnah also: "Do not exaggerate in praising me as the Christians did to (Jesus) the son of Mary, for I am only a servant, so say {he is} the servant of Allah and his Messenger." Sahih Bukhari.

Allah has sent many prophets and messengers to mankind before he sent our last and final prophet. Muslims believe in each and every one of these messengers and prophets, the message that they brought (Tawheed), without any distinction between them. All of them came to teach the people to worship Allah alone and to submit to his will. The prophets and Messengers dating back to Adam (alaihi salaam) taught us the good things we should do, and the bad things we should stay away from and not do.

Unfortunately, as time passed, the people forgot the teachings of the prophets. Some became evil and ignorant, so ignorant that they have changed the books of Allah that were revealed to these previous Prophets and Messengers. Still today in some societies you will find people who are worshipping prophets, statues, pictures and other objects in place of worshipping Allah Alone. May Allah protect all of us from this calamity Aameen

To deny Allah or the Sunnah of the Messenger (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) like this or in any other fashion (way) is called an act of <u>Kufr.</u> The one who denies Allah and worships anything other than Allah is called a <u>Kaafir.</u>

Most people believe in Allah, but some of them also believe that others share in Allah's powers and authority, or even that he has partners. This kind of incorrect belief is called **Shirk**. People who commit acts of shirk are called the **Mushrikûn**.

Allah has forbidden acts of Kufr and Shirk. When he sent the Prophet Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) to the world as his last Prophet. He came to remove Kufr and Shirk from the people by teaching them Tawheed.

Allah sent the last book <u>The Noble Quran</u> to the Messenger of Allah (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) by way of the Angel Jibril (alaihi salaam- Peace be upon him). The Noble Quran is the book of Allah. Allah has promised to protect the Noble book; therefore no one has the ability to change it, Alhamdulillah.

Review what we have learned:

- □ When you hear, see, or say the name of our Beloved Prophet Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) you must remember to send the salaams upon him. This is a command from your Rabb (Lord) Allah.
- □ The Prophet (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) has warned us in the Sunnah: "Do not exaggerate in praising me as the Christians did to (Jesus) the son of Mary, for I am only a servant, so say {he is} the servant of Allah and his Messenger." Sahih Bukhari.
- □ We know that the Prophet Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) was the last prophet sent to all of mankind, and that there will be no other prophet after him.
- □ We have learned that The Noble Quran, the book of Allah was the last revelation to be sent to all of mankind.

From the Book of Allah:

- □ "Say (O Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) to mankind): If you really love Allah then follow me (Islamic Monotheism, The Quran and The Sunnah), Allah will love you…" Ali-Imran: 31
- □ "Allah sends His Salaat (Graces, Honors, Blessings, Mercy) on the Prophet (Muhammad -(Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam), and also His angels (ask Allah to bless and forgive him). O you who believe! Send your Salat on him, and greet him with the Islamic way of greeting (As-salaamu Alaikum)." Al-Ahzab: 56
- "Those who disbelieved (Kafir) and hinder (men) from the path of Allah, for them, We will add torment to the torment because they used to spread corruption [by disobeying Allah themselves, as well as ordering others to do so]. An-Nahl: 88
- □ "Verily, Allah forgives not that partners should be set up with him (in worship), but He forgives except that (anything else) to whom He wills; and whoever sets up partners with Allah in worship, he has indeed invented a tremendous sin." An-Nisa: 48

Correct Answers for vocabulary: This key will is provided here in the first lesson so that you can familiarize yourselves with what is expected from you inshaAllah. All other worksheets in this series will not contain the answers for you; this will ensure that you are completing the required reading assigned.

Kaafir - The one who denies Allah and worships anything other than Allah

Arab – deserts and waste barren land well nigh waterless and treeless

Red Sea - a long arm of the Indian Ocean between northeast Africa and Arabia; linked to the Mediterranean at the north end by the Suez Canal

Muhsinun – good doers, who perform good deeds totally for Allah's sake only, without showing off or to gain praise or fame, etc. and do them in accordance to Allah's orders.

Hagar- Pharaoh's daughter, wife of Ibrahim, and mother of Ishmael

Kufr - To deny Allah or the Sunnah of the Messenger like this or in any other fashion (way) such as worshipping idols, prophets, etc...

Ibrahim - Prophet of Allah

Descendants - a person considered as descended from some ancestor or race

Tribes - A unit of sociopolitical organization consisting of a number of families, clans, or other groups who share a common ancestry and culture and among whom leadership is typically neither formalized nor permanent.

Rulership – Two types: Crowned Kings from Yemen Only; who were not independent; and heads of tribes and clans who enjoyed the same authorities and privileges possessed by crowned kings and were mostly independent.

Mushrikûn – Polytheist, pagans, idolaters, and disbelievers in the oneness of Allah and His Messenger Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam)

Shirk - to believe that others share in Allah's powers and authority, or even that he has partners. To worship other than Allah.

Submission - The act of submitting to the power of another

Ibaadah – Acts of worship solely for the pleasure of Allah

Sunnah – the way of life prescribed for Muslims on the basis of the teachings and practices of Muhammad (Salla allahu alaihi was sallaam) and interpretations of the Quran.

Humanity - Humans considered as a group; the human race

An-Nusub [5:3] –stone alters

Ka'bah - The first house of worship built by Ibrahim and Ishmael

Circumambulate - To walk around (something); The Ka'bah is circumambulated during Hajj
