The First Principle: Part 1

It is obligatory for you to have knowledge of:
The three fundamental principles of Islam

The first of them is to have knowledge of your (Rabb) Lord.

1. So, if you are asked "Who is your Lord?" Say

Allah says in the Qur'aan:

"Verily Allah is my Lord and the Lord of you All, so worship Him (alone), this is the straight path."

Surah Aali-Imran: 51

2. Give examples of Allah's signs.

"And from among His signs are the night and the day, and the sun and the moon. Prostrate yourselves neither to the sun nor to the moon, rather prostrate yourselves to Allah Who created them, if you (really) worship Him..."

Suratul Fussilat: 37

3. Why did Allah create you and the jinn?

"And I (Allah) did not create the jinn and mankind except that they should worship Me (alone)..."

Suratudh Dhaariyaat: 56-58
