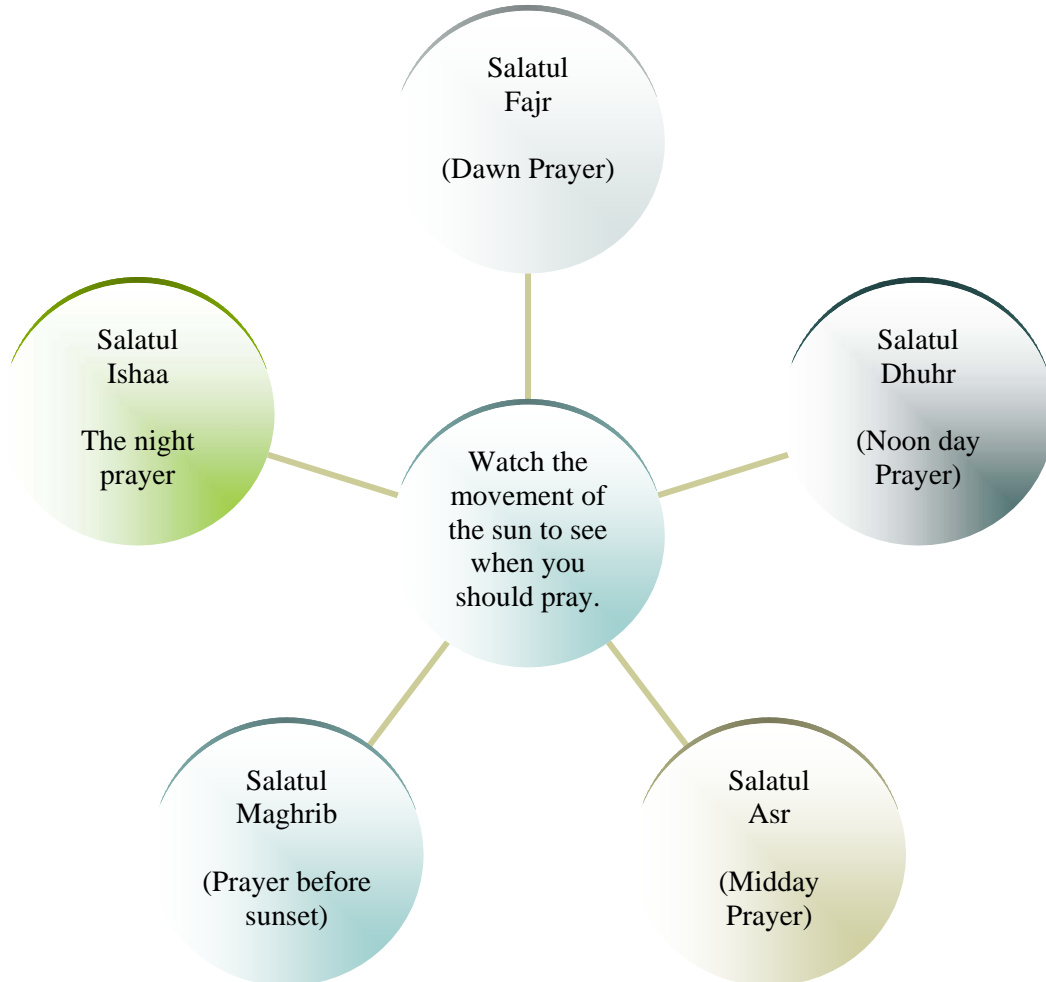
“Worship Allah alone, making all worship purely for Him, and do not associate anything in worship along with Him.” An-Nisa 4:36
