We are to:

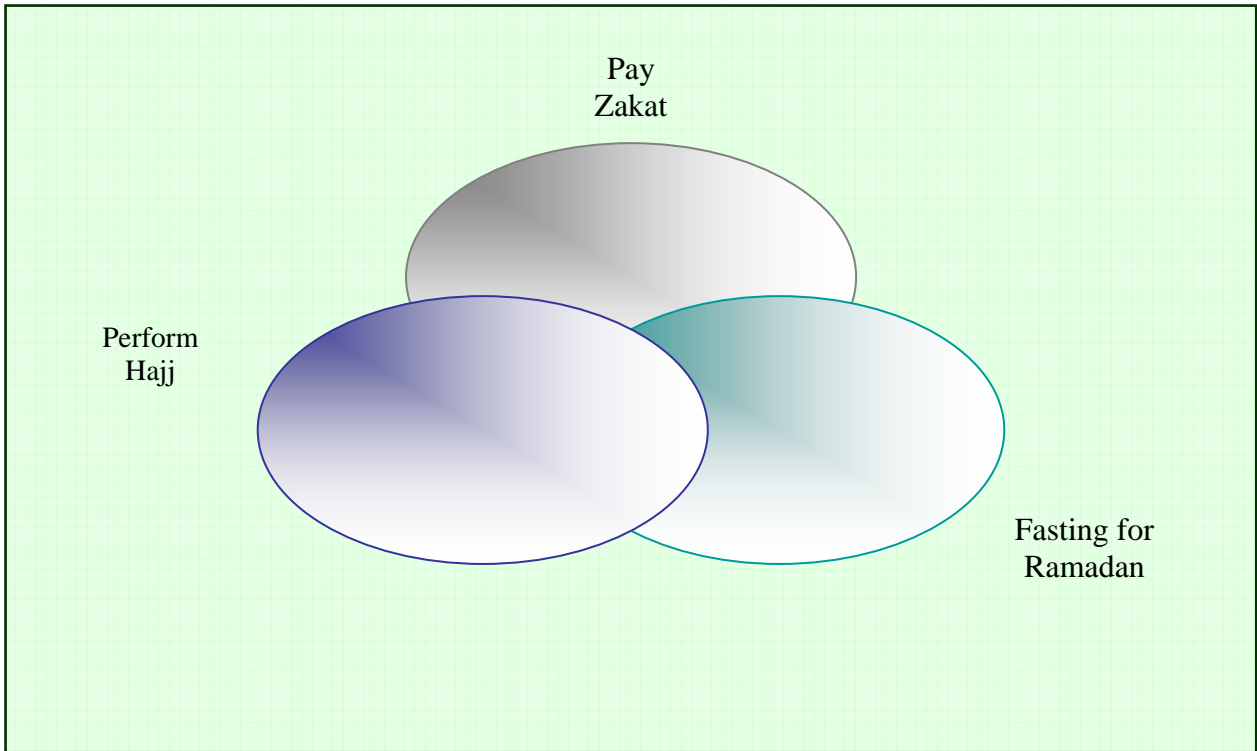
- Pay Zakat
