## The Second Principle: Part 2.4

### **“What is your religion?”**

*My religion is Islaam; (Islaam) means for you to submit ones self to Allah, and to turn to Him in obedience.*

### **What is Imaan (faith)?**

The creed of the Muslim is to believe in Allah, His Angels, His books, His Messengers, the Last Day, and the Qadar (Pre Decree):

Allah says in Surah Al-Baqarah 2:285

“The Messenger believes in what has been sent down to him from his Lord, and so do the believers. Each one believes in Allah His Angels, and His Books. (They say,) “We make no distinction between one another of His Messengers,” and they say, “We hear, and obey. We seek Your forgiveness our Lord, and to You is the return.”

**Proof for Al-Qadar:** Can be found in Surah Qamar: 49, (*read aloud*).

### **What is Ihsaan?**

To worship Allah as if you see Him, and though you do not see Him, verily he sees you. The proof for this is found in Suratun Nahl: 128 (*read aloud*)

## The Pillars of Imaan
