Lesson 16a: Surat Al-Asr

It is imperative that the student focus on learning the short Suwar; reciting them correctly, memorizing them, and their explanations which are required for one to understand inshaAllah. It is advised that the students use the class text, the Noble Qur'aan, and Part 30 of the Tafsir from Ibn Kathir for this course.

Each lesson shall be accompanied with vocabulary from the Surah, ahaadith in connection to the Surah, and may include some general words from the text.
