The Disciple

Introduction:

Assalaamu Alaikum wa Rahmatullahi wa Barakatahu, Ya Muslimoon may Allah the Bestower of Mercy, have mercy upon you and your families as you transverse upon this path of seeking beneficial knowledge Aameen.

You should have completed and read the previous accounts related about Abu Bakr As-Siddiq, Umar bin Al-Kittab, Uthmaan bin Affan, Ali bin Abi Talib (The four rightly guided caliphate) and Abu Dhar al-Gifari radi allahu anhumma before continuing on to this lesson.

We have discussed from our previous readings some of the continuous hardships, struggles, trials, and fitnah that occurred while establishing the Ummah. So far, we have learned the tremendous qualities of good manners, courageousness, honor, truthfulness, and zeal made for the sacrifices of Islam, and for establishing the belief that all of mankind should Worship Allah Alone and this is the establishment of Tawheed Alhamdulillah.

In this next section, we shall continue to learn about the companions of our beloved messenger, and they are many, they are those who stood firm in their belief, never wavering, or finding fault in what was presented to them.

They assisted in guiding the people to stay upon the path of righteousness which the messenger Muhammad (salla allahu alaihi wa sallaam) came with, (the Qur'aan and Sunnah) and they died upon that same belief.

10. Explain in details the events that are occurred in the battle of Uhud, that caused the defeat of the Muslim army. Be specific in your description regarding the act of disobedience.

11. Our beloved companion and brother of Safiyah bint Abdul Muttalib, Hamza (radi allahu anhu), was martyred and mutilated in the battle of Uhud. When Az-Zubair's mother wanted to come and see her brother the Prophet (salla allahu alayhi wa sallaam) told Az-Zubair (radi allahu anhu) to stop her. What was the prophet's advice?
