Lesson 4.2: Create a Timeline

Again, inshaAllah you shall become a historian. In this lesson you are being asked to create a timeline of events based upon what you have learned, or heard from people who are known to be trustworthy, rather than someone who has been known to add or omit statements.

The questions should help you create your time line of events accurately inshaAllah...

1. The Prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) started calling to Islam, who were the first four to accept Islam?
2. The Prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) preached for _____ in secrecy, where would they meet?
3. Apply the 4 R's (Read, Reflect, Remember, and Receive the benefits) for the following ayaat. (Arabic/English)

Therefore proclaim openly (Allah's Message of Islamic Monotheism) that which you are commanded, and turn away from Al-Mushrikeen (polytheists, idolaters, and disbelievers, etc. - see V.2:105). [Qur'an, Al-Hijr (15): 94].

4. The Prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) called a meeting on mount Safa, what did he tell the people?

***As a historian it is necessary that you report authentic findings from your research. What questions or comments do you have? We will submit your questions to Dr. Saleh as Saleh inshaAllah.**

5. Describe what happened as a result of Abu Lahab's disrespectful outburst.
6. The Prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) preached openly in Mecca for ten (10) years, write a list containing pieces of information that describe the sufferings of the Muslims at that time.
7. Give a detailed description for the significance of Abyssinia?



8. Tell what happened after Hamza bin Abdul Muttalib (radi allahu anhu) accepted Islam.
9. Interpret the follow phrase "The Year of Sorrow," Explain its meaning in detail.
10. State what happened in the eleventh year of Prophethood.
11. What is the significance of the first Pledge of al-Aqabah al Uulaa?
12. Name the companion sent to Al-Madinah to teach them Islam?
13. Can you give a brief description of how Islam began to spread in al-Madinah?
14. What was the 2nd pledge of al-Aqabah al Uulaa?
15. How was the Mushrikeen's plot to kill the prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) foiled?
16. What was the price/ransom offered to anyone who had information about the whereabouts of the prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam)?
17. Apply the 4 R's (Read, Reflect, Remember, and Receive the benefits) for the following ayaat. (Arabic/English)

If you help him (Muhammad salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) not (it does not matter), for Allah did indeed help him when the disbelievers drove him out, the second of two, when they (Muhammad salla allahu alaihi wa salaam and Abu Bakr) were in the cave, and he (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) said to his companion (Abu Bakr): "Be not sad (or afraid), surely Allah is with us." Then Allah sent down His Sakeenah (calmness, tranquility, peace, etc.) upon him, and strengthened him with forces (angels) which you saw not, and made the word of those who disbelieved the lowermost, while it was the Word of Allah that became the uppermost, and Allah is All-Mighty, All-Wise. [Qur'an, At-Tawbah (9): 40]
