HW10: Questionnaire (Sahih al-Bukhari Ahaadith 631 - 700)

1. What is the statement that the Mu'adhdhin is commanded (ordered) to say on cold or rainy nights during the call to prayer (Adhaan)?

2. In several Ahaadith it is reported that the prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa sallam) ordered that Abu Bakr (may Allah be pleased with him) be called to lead the prayer. Aisha (may Allah be pleased with her) stated: "He is a soft-hearted man and would not be able to lead the prayer in your place." Give further details about this statement from the other hadith on this subject.

3. In what hadith have we learned that clapping in the salaah is for the women?

4. What are some of the reasons given for the one leading the people in salaah to shorten the prayer? What three suwar were recommended?

5. There are several Ahaadith that mention the procedure for following the Imam in salaah, describe the procedures given.

Volume 1, Book 11, Number 642:

Narrated Nafi':

Ibn 'Umar said, "Allah's Apostle said, 'If the supper is served for anyone of you and the Iqama is pronounced, start with the supper and don't be in haste (and carry on eating) till you finish it.'" If food was served for Ibn 'Umar and Iqama was pronounced, he never came to the prayer till he finished it (i.e. food) in spite of the fact that he heard the recitation (of the Qur'an) by the Imam (in the prayer). Narrated Ibn 'Umar: The Prophet said, "If anyone of you is having his meals, he should not hurry up till he is; satisfied even if the prayer has been started."
