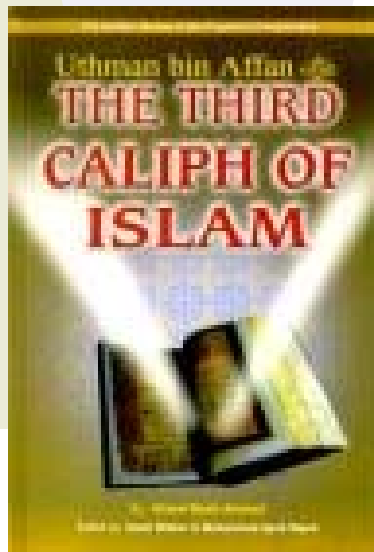



In the Name of Allah

23. How many Muslims gave a pledge to avenge the death of Uthman before they learned that, the news of his death was false?

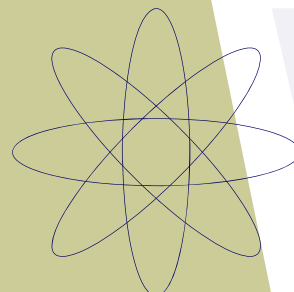
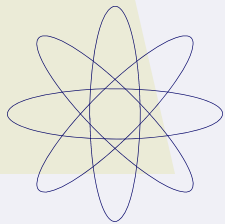
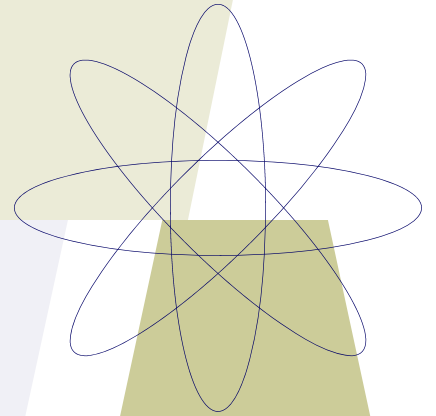
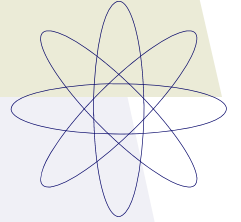
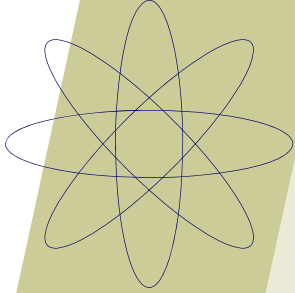
24. Tell us some of the good deeds that you remember hearing that Uthman did for the Islamic State.
